- 1. PCWCID #1 will pay Gordon \$90,000.00 subject to the conditions set forth below.
- 2. The offer includes tracts 4a, 6, 11 and 12 including any claim to the Comanche Creek right of way for a total of 25 acres more or less.
- 3. Stipulates that any revisionary interest in Blocks A & B reverts to PCWCID #1 in perpetuity.
- **4.** Includes any mineral rights to this area.
- 5. Current users of well located on tract 4a will continue to use the well until PCWCID # 1 has extended water supply lines to that area. At the time PCWCID#I has upgraded the infrastructure and water is available, current users of well located on 4a will no longer have use/access to that well and will become PCWCID#I customers. Current users will be allowed ninety days to finish the process of obtaining water tap after infrastructure is complete.
- **6.** Current users of well located on 4a will have 30 days after this sale is completed to apply for water tap with PCWCID #1. This information will be used by PCWCID #1 to notify users when infrastructure is complete. Fees for the water tap will not be collected until water tap is available.
- 7. Current users of well located on tract 4a are responsible for the maintenance of the well and repair well at their cost.
- 8. Current users of well located on tract 4a will use water for residential use only.
- 9. It is the duty of the seller to notify current users of stipulations concerning water well use.
